Before You Apply

Prior to completing an application, please read the entire **Vendor Application and Agreement** and make sure your product meets the criteria and that you can meet the rules of the market.

If you have not visited the market before, we strongly encourage you to do so before submitting an application.

Our Market Focus

The primary theme of the market is related to **produce, plants, and specialty foods**. Other products and goods that are accepted are intended to supplement the core theme while adding color and variety to the marketplace.

While not all supplemental products are homemade and/or handcrafted, we strongly emphasize those. Commercially manufactured products are generally **not a good fit** for the Celebration Farmers Market.

Business Licensing

Approved vendors at the Farmers Market must have a **Business License** from the city in which their business is located. If the vendor does not reside in a city, the vendor must obtain a business license from the county.

Licensing requirements for food vendors vary depending on the type of food being sold and whether you are operating under **Cottage Food Laws**.

If you are a food vendor, we suggest visiting the market and speaking with vendors who sell similar products to learn what licenses may be required.

It is the responsibility of each vendor to obtain all appropriate licenses and to have those licenses available in their booth at all times.
